3. Pledge of Allegiance
4. It was moved by Aldersperson Saryan, seconded by Aldersperson Bailey, to approve the December 6, 2016 Common Council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

7. Announcements – Taxes are due by January 31, 2017. State law governs when those are paid, how they can be collected. The treasurer's office has absolutely no discretion in changing any of the statutory guidelines with regard to that.

For the office of Mayor, both the current Mayor, Michael Neitzke, and Ben Rucka of 5223 S. 49th Street have completely filed the paperwork to run for election. There will not be a primary for that election. That election will be April 4, 2017. For the office of aldersperson in District #1, Aldersperson Lubotsky, the incumbent, along with Denise R. Collins, 4439 S. 38th Street, Cord J. Harris of 4393 S. 38th Street, and Shawn Hart of 3416 S. Crandon Place have all filed their paperwork as required and there will be a spring primary on February 21, 2017 for that office. The office of Aldersperson in District #2, Aldersperson Bruce R. Bailey, the incumbent, of 4281 S. 81st Street has a challenger in James Palmar, 5001 S. 68th Street. There will not be a primary for that election but it will be part of the spring election on April 4th.
