

MINUTES OF THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT THE GREENFIELD CITY HALL ON TUESDAY, JUNE 21, 2016

Ald. Lubotsky nominated Ald. Bailey for Chairperson. There being no other nominations, Ald. Bailey was elected Chairperson by unanimous vote.

5. Discussion and decision regarding an amendment to the Municipal Code for Chp. 21 Zoning Code text changes to have Gun Shops and firearms/ammo sales be designated as a Special Use in all non-residential zoning categories. (Chuck Erickson, Community Development Manager)

Mr. Erickson said that the Plan Commission has forwarded a recommendation to both authorize a public hearing process to begin and to approve a Zoning Code text change to remove ‘gun shops’ and ‘firearms/ammo’ from the zoning use category of ‘sporting goods store’, and then to designate them as a Special Use. This would mean a public hearing and subsequent approval would be needed before the Common Council, for any sale of guns and firearms/ammo. In an answer to a question from the committee, it was noted that the process to initiate this change started with a recommendation from the Police Dept. which the Plan Commission clearly concurred with.

It was moved by Ald. Saryan, seconded by Ald. Bailey to approve the recommendation for an amendment to the Chapter 21 Zoning Code for text changes to have ‘Gun Shops’ and ‘firearms/ammo sales’ be designated as a Special Use in all non-residential zoning categories (i.e. except as noted in the draft Ordinance, not in the Office, Institutional, and Park & Recreation districts), and authorize the public hearing process to proceed. On a roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.
