Greenfield, Wisconsin

West Neighborhood

- Enhance character of Hwy 100 Corridor
- Focus on key infill/redevelopment sites (e.g. Allis Chalmers, Intersection of Hwy 100 and Layton)
- Invest in community gateway improvements
- Capitalize on interchange development opportunities
- Enhance greenway Corridor Connections

Northeast Neighborhood

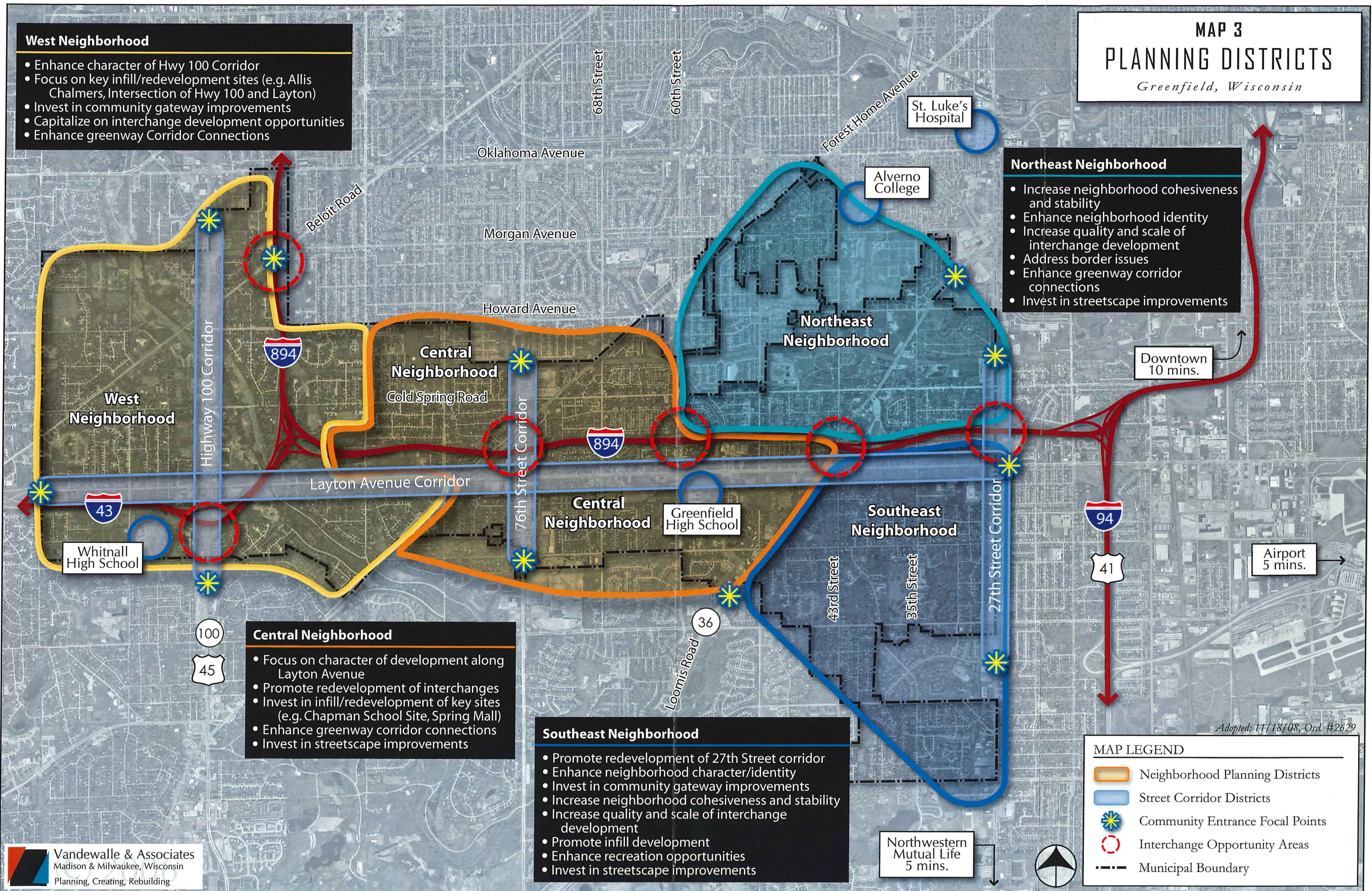
- Increase neighborhood cohesiveness and stability
- Enhance neighborhood identity
- Increase quality and scale of interchange development
- Address border issues
- Enhance greenway corridor connections
- Invest in streetscape improvements

Central Neighborhood

- Focus on character of development along Layton Avenue
- Promote redevelopment of interchanges
- Invest in infill/redevelopment of key sites (e.g. Chapman School Site, Spring Mall)
- Enhance greenway corridor connections
- Invest in streetscape improvements

Southeast Neighborhood

- Promote redevelopment of 27th Street corridor
- Enhance neighborhood character/identity
- Invest in community gateway improvements
- Increase neighborhood cohesiveness and stability
