### PROGRAM OPTIONS

The Kids Connection Before and After School program is available to those who are registered students from K4-5<sup>th</sup> grades at Glenwood, Maple Grove, Edgewood, & Elm Dale. Care is available before school or after school. The program is held in either the cafeteria or dedicated classroom area.

### PROGRAM TIMES

Before School (AM): 6:30 AM-8:45 AM  
After School (PM): 3:25 PM-6:00 PM

### PROGRAM FEES

**Sibling Discounts** are available to those whose children attend 3+ days per week. The first child is the full price and each child after that will receive a 10% discount.

### DAILY SCHEDULE

The before and after school program daily schedule varies per school but will include free choice play, snack (PM only) organized activities, and physical indoor/outdoor activities. Weekly or monthly themes are used as well. The program is designed to balance the child's day of learning at school through a variety of fun experiences to set the groundwork for a lifetime of learning outside of the classroom.

### SCHOOL'S OUT DAYS

The Kids Connection program holds School's Out Days for a separate fee at Elm Dale elementary school during school holidays and vacations. This program is open to all students from all Greenfield School District elementary schools. School's Out Day program runs 6:30 AM-6:00 PM and sometimes contains field trips. **Maximum: 60 Participants/Schools Out Day.**

### PAYMENTS WITH CALENDARS

Once you are enrolled in the program, you must prepay monthly or 10 days in advance of service. To do so, you must fill out a monthly or yearly calendar. These calendars allow you to select which days of the month your child(ren) will attend our program. Monthly calendars will be available at each Kids Connection Site, online or in the Parks & Recreation office.

### ENROLLMENT

A Kids Connection Registration Form must be filled out annually for each child attending any Kids Connection program, including school's out days and early release days. Once this form is complete, participants will have access to enroll in any of the Kids Connection programs for the 2019-2020 school year. ## SCHOOL'S OUT AND EARLY RELEASE DAYS

*Need care for your child when school is out?*

Leave the planning to us! Schools Out Days will be filled with special activities, games, crafts, and creativity with a special theme or field trip. **School's Out Days will be held at Elm Dale Elementary** and children can be dropped off anytime beginning at 6:30 AM and must be picked up by 6:00 PM. This program is available only to all Greenfield School District Elementary school student.

**Snacks** will be provided in the morning and afternoon, please **(send your child with a sack lunch)**. Children should be properly dressed for active play, including gym shoes.

Early Release Days will be held at all schools from the afternoon bell until 6:00 PM. Extra activities and experiences will be scheduled for these days. Early release afternoon care is only \$15.00. If you attend before and after school on an early release day, it is included in your normal weekly fee. Spring 2020 Early Release days are February 11 and June 12.

**To register**, please follow Kids Connection registration instructions. **Pre-Registration is required. Field trip fees include bus transportation and admission unless otherwise noted.**

**School's Out Days are not offered on:**

Dec. 23, 24, 25, 30, and 31; Jan. 1; Apr. 10; and May 25.

### Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> WEATHER DAY

### Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> MUSEUM AND PLANETARIUM
