

OPEN SWIM POLICIES



DAILY ADMISSION (Cash Only)

Adults (18+) = \$4/person

Youth (3-17) = \$2/person

Infants (0-2) = Free

- Youth 11 and under must be accompanied by an adult (18+).
- Youth 5 and under must have an adult in the water and within arm's reach at all times.
- All patrons entering the pool deck must pay an entrance fee. This includes those who are not swimming as well as adults who are accompanying youth 11 and under.

GENERAL PROGRAM POLICIES

- Patrons are not permitted to enter the water until a Lifeguard is on deck. Lifeguards will signal once patrons can enter the water.
- Showers are required before entering the pool.
- Proper swim attire must be worn in the water. Street wear (t-shirts, pants, shorts, socks, underwear, etc.) is not allowed. Swim Shirts are available to purchase at the admissions table.
- Swim diapers must be worn by all non-toilet trained patrons. Swim diapers are available to purchase at the admissions table.
- Food and beverages are not allowed on the pool deck.
- All youth 17 and younger must pass a swim test to swim in the deep end. Adults 18+ will be required to pass a swim test to bring a non-deep water swimmer into the deep end.
- Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) must be US Coast Guard approved. PFD's that are not US Coast Guard approved are not permitted in the water.
- Do not enter the pool if you have a communicable disease, an open cut, or if you have had diarrhea in the past two weeks.
- No running, shoving, pushing, dunking, riding on shoulders, or "rough housing".
- No hanging or sitting on the lane lines.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in removal from the facility.
